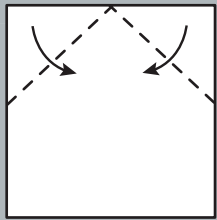




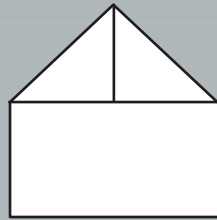

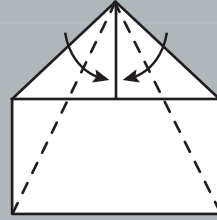
DECORATE THE TABLE TURKEY: PART I



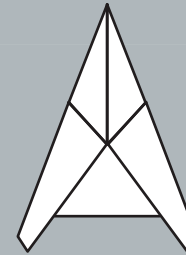
Step 1: Start with a flat, open Dinu napkin. Fold the top right and left corners to the middle.



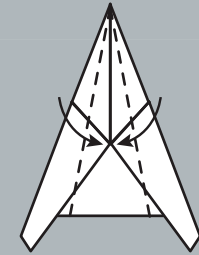
Step 2: Your napkin should look like this.



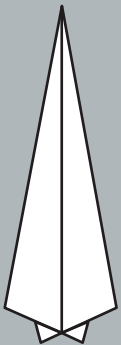
Step 3: Make a second fold to meet in the middle.



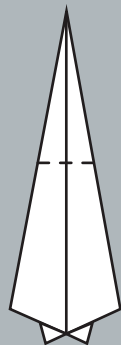
Step 4: Your napkin should look like this



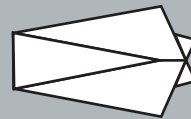
Step 5: Make a thirn fold to meet in the middle.



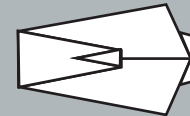
Step 6: Your napkin should look like this.



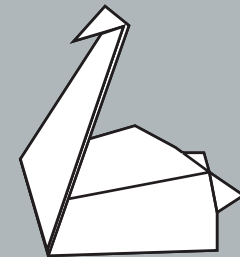
Step 7: Fold the napkin to form the body.

Step 7: Fold the tip down to create the beak.



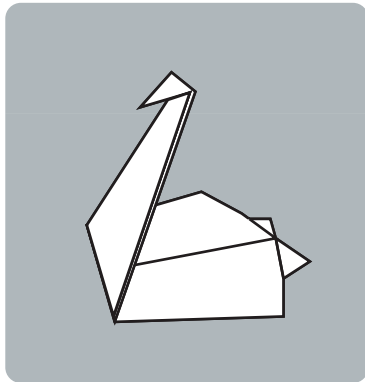
Step 8: Your napkin should look like this when standing upright.



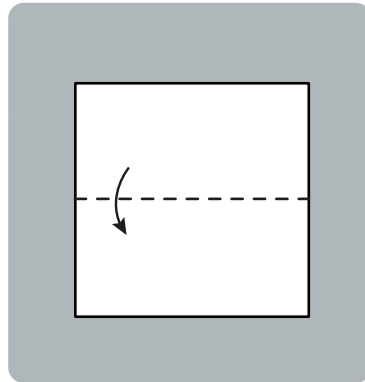

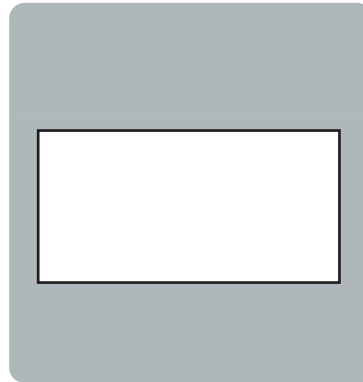
DECORATE THE TABLE TURKEY: PART 2



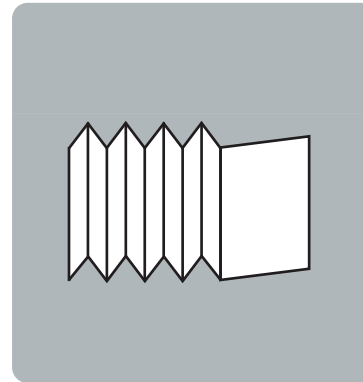
Step 1: Continuation from P1.



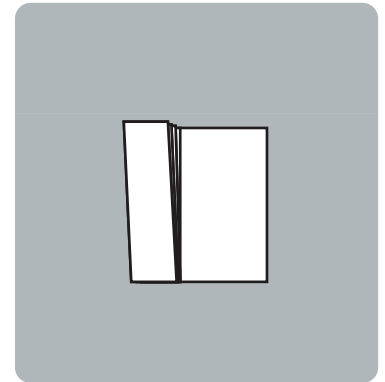
Step 2: Take another flat, open DINU napkin



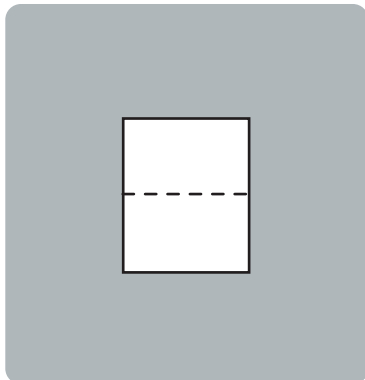
Step 3: and fold it in half to form a rectangle.



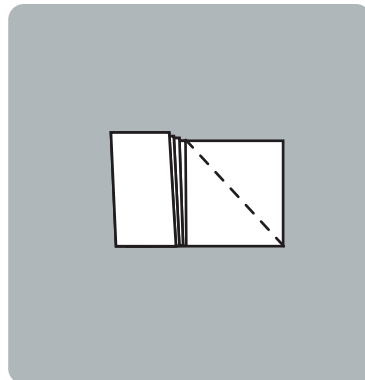
Step 4: Fold the napkin in an accordion style, leaving about 7.5cm unfolded.



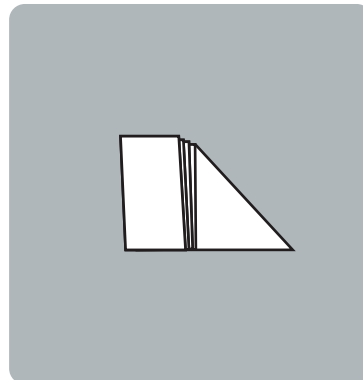
Step 5: Turn the napkin over so that the accordion portion faces down.



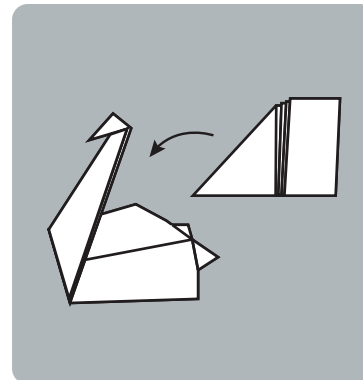
Step 6: Fold the napkin in half.



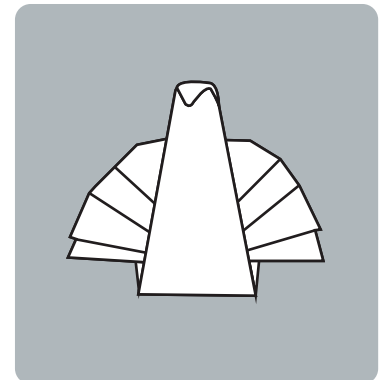
Step 7: Fold and tuck the unfolded portion of the napkin into the center accordion slot.



Step 8: Your napkin should look like this.



Step 7: Place the accordion portion behind the neck of the turkey on top of the body.



Step 8: Your two napkins should look like this.
